

PROVIDER BULLETIN

~ REFERRAL MODIFICATION REQUESTS ~

Preferred IPA is committed to simplifying processes for our participating physicians. Please review this helpful guide to determine whether a referral MODIFICATION or a NEW SUBMISSION should be sent.

NEW REFERRAL SUBMISSION REQUIRED IF (web & fax submission):

- Authorization has expired AND has already been previously extended.
- Authorization has already been valid for 6 months AND not used.
- Authorization <u>only</u> requires Additional Codes No deletion of any codes
- Patient requesting a second opinion

MODIFICATION SUBMISSION PERMITTED IF (Phone, web & fax requests):

- Extension Requests:
 - o Patient has appointment after authorization expiration date
 - Appointment date or month specialist is scheduling for must always be provided with any verbal, written or web modification requests.
 - If authorization is for outpatient services, please call our customer service department at 800-874-2091 to have authorization extended over the phone.
- Provider Change Requests (Web & fax submission):
 - o Only allowed for open authorizations and unused authorizations
 - o Provider does not have any appointments for 2 months or longer
 - o Provider does not see patients member's age
 - o Please do not submit member provider preference changes
- Service/CPT Code Changes (Web & fax submission):
 - o Request is to Delete codes AND Add new codes
 - Provide: Codes to be deleted
 - Provide: Codes to be added
- Closure Request Referral Submitted in Error (Web & fax submission):
 - o Provide explanation for closure request (wrong member, no longer needed, etc.)

If a modification request does not meet criteria above, it will be closed with no changes and a response sent to the requesting provider with this modification requirement bulletin information.

Please do not submit modification requests due to "member preference." This includes requests for a closer provider. Please inform members that the available specialists are selected based upon the distance from member and contracted hospital's participating available specialists.
